## WESTERN UNDERGRADUATE EXCHANGE

### Eligibility Requirements

New undergraduate students enrolling at SJSU for the first time may apply for WUE if they meet the following requirements found at [sjsu.edu/admissions](https://sjsu.edu/admissions)

### First-Time, First-Year (Freshmen)

First-Time, First-Year applicants must meet the non-CA resident CSU and SJSU admission requirements.

### Upper Division Transfer

Upper Division Transfer applicants must meet CSU and SJSU admission requirements.

### Additional Requirements

The WUE Program is open to U.S. Citizens and non-citizens legally present in the United States.

Students planning to study at SJSU with an F or J visa type are not eligible for the WUE program.

Students pursuing a second bachelor's degree, credential, master's, doctoral, or Extended University programs are not eligible to participate in WUE.

WUE students are not eligible for California resident tuition and cannot apply time accrued while participating in the WUE program to establish California residency.

### Applying for SJSU's WUE Program

- Apply to one of the SJSU majors accepting WUE students at Cal State Apply.
- After you have been admitted to SJSU, complete and submit the WUE application for SJSU.

### Cost of Attendance (per academic year)

The tuition and fees are based on a calculation of full-time enrollment at 12 units

| Tuition Type         | Tuition & Fees                       | Total    |
|----------------------|--------------------------------------|----------|
| Resident tuition     | \$7,248 (tuition) + \$2,715 (fees)   | \$9,963  |
| Non-resident tuition | \$9,963 (tuition & fees) + \$11,952* | \$21,915 |
| WUE tuition**        | \$10,872 (tuition) + \$2,715 (fees)  | \$13,587 |

\*Non-resident tuition is an additional \$498/unit

\*\* WUE tuition and fees are 150% of regular tuition

### WUE Savings

\$21,915 (non-resident tuition & fees) – \$13,587 (WUE tuition & fees) = **\$8,328**
